Springfield, Illinois - The City of Springfield Office of Public Works is reminding the community that due to the International Route 66 Mother Road Festival this weekend (September 23 - 25), the following areas will be closed to vehicular traffic. Please note: the Old Capitol Farmers Market is also occurring on Saturday. It is still on Adams Street but will move one block west between 4th and 2nd Street just for this weekend.

PARKING RESTRICTIONS

Parking on the following streets will be prohibited after 10:00 a.m., Friday, September 23.

- Fourth Street between Capitol and Washington
- Fifth Street between Madison and Jefferson, on the east side
- Fifth Street between Jefferson and Jackson
- Sixth Street between Jefferson and Capitol
- Seventh Street between Madison and Jefferson, on the east side
- Seventh Street between Jefferson and Capitol
- Washington between Third and Fourth Street, the south side of the street only
- Washington between Fourth and Ninth Street
- Adams between Second and Seventh Street
- Monroe between Third and Seventh Street
- Capitol between Fourth and Seventh Street

ROAD CLOSURES

On Friday, September 23, at 12-noon, the following roads will be closed to traffic.

- Fifth Street at Jefferson
- Sixth Street closed between American Legion Drive (Sangamon Alley) and Jefferson
- Capitol between Fourth and Seventh Street
- Monroe at Third Street, east of the railroad tracks
- Adams Street between Second and Seventh Street
- Washington Street, east of Fourth Street

On Friday, September 23, at 5:00 p.m., the following roads will be CLOSED to traffic.

- Seventh Street at Jefferson
- Parking ramp at Seventh and Washington – will allow for one lane to exit on Washington between Seventh and Ninth Street as well as one exit lane on Seventh Street, south to Monroe.
- Monroe at Third Street, west of the railroad tracks
- Closing Fourth at Capitol Avenue
- Closing the east side of Fourth Street (parking lane and thru lane) from Jackson to Capitol, leaving the west side of Fourth Street (parking lane and one thru lane) open for vehicles to proceed north on Fourth then west onto Capitol.
