Project Description:
The project consists of rehabilitating the existing brick, concrete, clay, and truss combined
sewers (various sizes) within the Cook Street Sewer District bounded by Eleventh Street, Cook
Street, Martin Luther King Jr. Drive, and South Grand Avenue by means of cured in place pipe
(CIPP). Rehabilitation shall also consist of manhole rehabilitation where identified on the Plans.
Manhole rehabilitation shall include pavement replacement, manhole removal and replacement,
channel and/or bench rehabilitation, removal and replacement of frames and lids, grouting, cleaning
and prepping manholes, patching and sealing/lining.

Benefits for Community:

- Newly lined sewer mains, which lessens inflow and infiltration.
- Less maintenance construction on sewers throughout the years after completion.
- Improvement of stormwater drainage into sewers.
- Extends life of sewers at lower cost than replacement.
