CITY OF SPRINGFIELD COMPLETES THE CONVERSION OF SELECT STREETS TO TWO-WAY TRAFFIC WITH REVERSE-ANGLE PARKING

SPRINGFIELD, IL- The City of Springfield is pleased to announce the completion of the conversion of select one-way streets to two-way traffic. This project, aimed at improving traffic flow and accessibility, includes the following streets:

- **4th Street from South Grand Ave to Dodge St**
- **Adams Street from 6th St to 9th St**

In addition to the two-way conversions, reverse-angle parking has been implemented on the south side of Adams Street.

Important Safety Notice: Drivers and pedestrians are urged to exercise additional caution when traveling in these newly converted areas. Both during the conversion period and for an extended time afterward, it is crucial to remain vigilant and aware of all directions of traffic. When approaching and entering intersections and driveways, please be attentive to vehicles and pedestrians who may be unfamiliar with the new traffic patterns.

Specific Instructions for Adams Street:

- Parking on the south side of Adams Street is now reverse-angle parking. Drivers should follow posted signage and markings to ensure proper and safe parking.
